# 5. Agenda Items

- 1. Concert reflections
  - 1. We had over 50 performers
  - 2. We had a few too many pizzas but there was a pretty good number
  - 3. Everyone played pretty well
  - 4. The poles on the stage were a logistical challenge
  - 5. Lighting was different which made the lighting at the sides of the stage was quite low
  - 6. Audience was a good size
  - 7. Maybe next time we could count audience numbers
  - 8. Not all groups kept to their 15 minutes. We started on time but it went longer then we expected.
  - 9. Set up times between groups was the fastest it has ever been. It would still be good to have it faster
  - 10. Next time each groups performance time should be more defined and clearer
  - 11.30 people came to the after party
  - 12. Committee bring food was good and created a good environment
  - 13. Access to the building was challenging. The building door was locked which meant that Damien had to stand at the door to let people in. Previously the doors have not been locked. We assumed booking the room would give us access to the building.
  - 14. People found the way we set up the stage/time taken. There is no perfect way to do this. We should look at different stage set ups for next concert.
  - 15. Jenny has suggested we try again for a big finale piece that involves all people/groups. There would be logistical issues to overcome.

- 16. Lots of people who only perform in the first half do not stay for the second half.
- 17. For all events we will need an equipment list and an equipment manager will need to be appointed
- 18. Lettisia did not submit the Uke program notes. The only reason it was in the program was because it was Lauren got info from reports.
- 19. We need a template for program info. We will need song title, composer, arranger, etc. We could also create a template for how to submit performers names.
- 20. We need to look at the layout/formatting of the program to save space, appearance

- 22. If any group needs a sound check they need to let the committee know a few weeks before the concert so this can be scheduled.

- 24. It was disappointing that no one from Link Arts was there. We still need their support and we do not feel like we are getting it. Andrew could bring this up at the next Arts Council meeting but we shouldn't really expect anything to come of this.
- 25. The balloons were a nice touch for theming the concert
- 26. Due to building works, Kaleide will be unavailable next semester (if they are running on time).
- 27. Notes from Jenny
  - 1. Do we want the MC to just read the names of the groups and pieces or should they elaborate? We should define the role of the MC and discuss whether each group should have a person to introduce their pieces.
  - 2. Entrance and exit etiquette for the groups.
  - 3. Jenny does not like the banners being used for orchestral groups. Adding them and removing them

will be a logistical nightmare. If Jenny would like to do this she needs to suggest a way this could be done without adding more time and confusion to stage management and provide a person to co-ordinate this.

4. If we use Story Hall next semester, do they have risers to put at the front of the stage to create a lower performance space

# 2. Camp

- 1. We need 2 alternative performance spaces aside from Nursing Homes. We should look at RSLs, open community spaces and pubs. We need to research the space we will perform in to ensure it will be appropriate.

### 6. Other Business

- 1. Lauren sent an email requesting a break down of the funding we received. The response did not contain a full break down like last time. The response was essentially "You received \$\$\$ for Semester 1"
- 2. Lauren suggested that Chamber Orchestra becomes a collective under the banner of RMIT Music. Damien will suggest this to Jenny at the next CO Meeting.
- 3. Any groups doing their own performances should ensure there is RMIT Music paraphernalia there. i.e. standing banner, banners either on stands or on a stand/podium to the side.
- 4. Semester 2 membership product needs to be submitted by David.
- 5. We need to let all continuing members know they will need to purchase Semester 2 membership. Do once the product is available.
- 6. Jenny mentioned that during the Kaleide renovation she would like to have the Choral library moved to the music room. Hosting the library would give us more validity in claiming the music room. Link would still take care of the library.
- 7. We need to develop a full and detailed asset list. RMIT want to know what each of its groups owns. We may need to have this finalised by the end of June. We will need a list of assets as well as photos. Jenny will organise photos on Library Day.
- 8. David has limited time to commit the to the group. He has large work and study commitments. Would we like another person to take over his role as president?
  - 1. There are no issues with his performance. He stays for as long as he is happy to be in the role
- 9. Can we add a mission statement to the constitution? It should outline our core values and goals.

If no solution is reached it may need to be bought to the committee but this will need to be at the discretion of the conductor and representative.
